## CHAMBER CONSIDERS WORKSHOP FOR MEMBERS

The **Morden & District Chamber of Commerce** is consulting with **Mediation Services** (Resolution Skills Centre) with regard to providing an Interpersonal Conflict Resolution workshop entitled "**How to Deal with Difficult People**" some time this fall. This is a two-day training that can be offered consecutively or spaced over four weeks in either 2 full day or 4 half day formats for a maximum 20 participants. Cost is being discussed at approximately \$250 per person.

This training offers the tools to manage conflict. You will explore how you respond to conflict and consider how that affects your life; learn practical skills to use in difficult situations; and increase your abilities to engage others to resolve conflicts.

The **Manitoba Business Awards** were established in 1983 by the **Manitoba Chambers of Commerce** to recognize and celebrate outstanding business and individual achievements by the Manitoba business community.

Any business that has operated successfully for a minimum of three years are eligible to self nominate or be nominated by another party. All nominees are evaluated for financial success (all information is handled in the strictest confidence by CGA's); sustained growth; contribution to employment in Manitoba in the past two years; employee relations/ development; and community involvement. Additional consideration may be given to nominees demonstrating special achievements or overcoming unique obstacles.

Award Categories include **Outstanding Large Business** (200+ employees); **Outstanding Medium Business** (31-200); **Outstanding Small Business** (less than 30 employees); **Outstanding Manitoba Ambassador** (out-of-province activities). **Lieutenant Governors Awards** are Outstanding Contribution to the Community for an Individual and a Business.
