PEMBINA VALLEY PASSPORT ADVENTURE - LAUNCH SET FOR MAY 1ST -

The official launch of the 3rd annual Pembina Valley Passport Adventure 2010 will occur on May 1st, 2010 at the Southland Mall from 10am - 4pm.

The launch will feature interactive exhibits from the 19 museums within the Pembina Valley and fun for the whole family.

A new addition to the launch is a Pembina Valley version of the popular TV show, "Antiques Road Show," featuring antique appraiser Terry Smith. Residents of the Pembina Valley are invited to bring their antique artifacts to the launch to receive a professional appraisal. It is recommended that people book an appointment with the appraiser by calling

324-8641, although drop-ins will be accommodated when possible. There is a \$7 cost per item. All funds raised will support the Passport Adventure program.

The official opening to the launch will take place at 10am sharp and include Mayor Martin Harder of Winkler as a guest speaker. A committee member of the Pembina Valley Passport Adventure will also share some words with the crowd.

The Passport Adventure Program is celebrating the enrolment of 5 new member museums in 2010! Come down to the Southland Mall and be the 1st to pick up a 2010 Passport. The Passports list all participating museums in the region and participants receive a stamp in their passport at each museum they visit. At the end of the season, the passports are entered into a generous prize draw.

This is a great and convenient opportunity for residents of the Pembina Valley to get a glimpse into the wonderful heritage of their region. Also, it is a unique opportunity to receive a professional appraisal on their antique artifacts.
